A regular meeting of the Faculty Senate convened at 3:03 pm on Sep 19, 2023, at the Dalton Woods Auditorium at LSU campus, the President being the Chair and Secretary being present. President Bazayev noted that this is a Hispanic Heritage month. There were no public comments on the agenda items. The minutes of the last meeting were adopted unanimously following a motion by Farasat.

In her report, President Bazayev mentioned she has been elected as the Chair of the LSU Council of Faculty Advisors. She along with Vice-President Tirone attended the Board of Supervisors meeting on 9/8/23 and presented the report from LSU A&M. The report emphasized the need of overcoming AAUP's double censures on LSU. In other updates, she mentioned the concerns expressed by various faculty on the process of Graduate Student Evaluation and that FSEC is in touch with the Pinkie Gordon Lane Graduate School on this issue. President Bazayev communicated to senators a request from the Committee on Committees on filling vacancies in different Faculty Senate committees. Finally, she mentioned that a luncheon with new senators was organized on 9/6/23 and one with Faculty Senate Committee Chairs is scheduled on 9/26/23.

The Unfinished Business from the previous meeting concerned the second reading of Resolution 23-04 concerning proposed increase in instructor salaries in the College of Humanities and Social Sciences (HSS). Given that Provost Haggerty has provided additional funds for the increase in instructor salaries in HSS, LeBlanc moved to withdraw the motion. There were no objections. Passed unanimously.

The Faculty Senate then proceeded with the election of a vacant Member-at-Large position in the FSEC from the new senators. The nominees were Farasat and Osborn. After a call by President Bazayev for any nominations from the floor, Snow moved to close the nominations. This motion was passed unanimously. Farasat and Osborn presented their statements and voting was conducted by Singh by roll call. Of the present senators, 30 voted in favor of Osborn, 10 in favor of Farasat and 7 abstained. President Bazayev declared Osborn as a new Member-at-Large in FSEC.

Vice-President Tirone gave a presentation on the Guidance on Minutes of the Meetings from Robert's Rules of Order. In the ensuing discussion senators asked for further guidance, including situations when the quorum is not present, and whether recordings need to be posted along with the minutes.

As the Chair of ad hoc FS IT committee, Singh gave a report on the progress on review of various IT policies. In the subsequent discussion, senators acknowledged the complex and intricate task at hand and expressed concerns on lengthy policies and standards and ongoing problems with software acquisition process.

President Bazayev then introduced Associate Vice President Stephen Beck who gave a presentation on the research security implications of NSPM-33, CHIPS and Science Act and the Higher Education Foreign Security Act of 2022. In the consecutive discussion senators discussed the language used for candidates from foreign adversaries, export controls, IRB and difficulties faced by international students.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:00 pm following a motion by Mattza. Passed unanimously.
